Activating Java for Simulations

Java <u>MUST</u> be installed on your machine. If it is not the simulations will not run. Goto <u>https://java.com/en/download/</u> to install.

If Java is installed and you call up a simulation webpage and you get the following error:



Follow the following steps:

- 1) Exit out of your browser
- 2) Go to CONTROL PANNEL and find ^{Java} and click on the icon.
- Go to the SECURITY TAB and click on the Edit Site List and add <u>http://tech-uofm.info</u> to the list. The screen should now appear as follows:
